Project: Additions & Renovations

Project Cost: \$1.4 million

Description of Work: Construction consists of brick and concrete block addition, a full basement and extensive demolition to an existing church building. The addition includes a new Fellowship Hall, Kitchen area, Restrooms, Bridal Lounge, Vesting/Sacristy, Three-floor stop Elevator and Carport. The renovated area consisted of the Nave, Altar, Sacristy and Choir Loft. The Nave received a new baptismal font.

Demolition: Cut new openings thru concrete basement walls at lower level and thru brick and block walls at the first floor locations. Removal of the lower level concrete tunnel connection walls, concrete steps, shored slab and concrete base slab between the church and school. Careful removal and storage of stained glass windows including the eight foot diameter rose window. Removal and storage of stone arched trim, columns, bases and statue.

Basis Construction:

Building Addition - 10,327 sq. ft.

Building Renovation— 5,945 sq. ft.

Foundations - concrete footings and basement walls

Structural Steel - framing at precast deck, steel stairs, lintels over openings, steel joist and deck

Floors— concrete slab on grade, concrete topping on precast plank, wood floor at choir loft

Exterior Walls - brick, colored split face block, concrete backup block, 2" rigid insulation and poured cavity insulation

Roof - wood truss framing, roof sheathing, felt and clay tile, singly ply membrane

Doors and Frames - aluminum entrances, hollow metal, solid wood doors, custom stile and rail wood doors

Windows - aluminum, existing stained and rose window

Interior Walls - wood stud, sound insulation, drywall and concrete block

Floor Covering - carpet, vinyl composition tile, ceramic tile, sealed concrete

Finishes - paint, ceramic wall tile, colored split face brick

Ceilings - acoustical panels, vinyl gypsum board tile

Specialties: extensive millwork in Gathering Space – setting stone statue, base, columns and arched trim, Baptismal Font, Casework, Elevator
